Day 1**BOS -Millennium Glen-Seneca Lake-Niagara Fall**

(Activity time: 11 -13 hours. Distance: 350 miles)

Hotel: Radisson/Holiday Inn or similar

Watkins Glen (45mins) (*Considering of the time/traffic/weather)

(* Because the canyons are all rocks and waterfalls, will be closed on rainy days and winters, and opened to the public from May to October every year. Besides that, due to the long distance to the Niagara Fall, the driver's driving time is restricted by law every day. If the traffic jams and weather of the day are not allowed, for security reasons, the company reserves the right to change or cancel the attraction.)

Watkins Canyon is located in the Five Fingers Lakes area of New York State in the United States. This is one of the most concentrated areas of waterfalls in the U.S. It is regarded as stratified rock geology and is eroded by glaciers and streams to form a strange landscape. Considered one of the most amazing landscapes in the world. There are about 400 miles of water in the two-mile gorge. There are 19 waterfalls along its route. Here, you can overlook the canyon along the edge walk, you can hike through the hiking trails in the canyon, and you can enjoy the waterfalls up close. Tourists love this canyon so much and named it "Millennium Glen".

Finger Lakes (25mins)

Finger Lakes are a group of 11 long, narrow, roughly north-south lakes in an area informally called the Finger Lakes region in Central New York. The name of the lake is Indian. The Indian legend says the Creator was resting with his hands while creating everything. But geologists explain that Finger Lake was formed due to the continuous erosion of the land by glaciers during the Ice Age. Seneca Lake is the largest glacier Finger Lake in New York State, and the deepest lake in the state. Due to the unique climate of Lake Seneca, there are more than 50 wineries here. Comparable to California's NAPA winery.

Overtime Activity:

Colorful waterfall (120mins)

(Adult: \$35/person; Child (under 12years old): \$25/person):

Deep into Niagara Falls State Park and see a wide range of exotic flowers; step on the observation platform of Terrapin Point of Goat Island, and Luna Island, touch the water in the nearest distance. Experience the colorful night view of the three major waterfalls [Horseshoe Falls], [Bridal Veil Falls], and [American Falls], as well as the magnificent nature.

Day 2**Niagara Fall-Toronto Canada**

(Activity time: 11-13 hours. Distance: 150 miles)

Hotel: Radisson/Holiday Inn or similar

Touching Niagara Fall (Summer: Maid of Mist; Winter: IMAX Movie, 120minutes)

On viewing waterfall observation deck, you can overlook the spectacular Niagara Fall in the Daytime. Put on raincoat, take the "Maid of Mist" cruise, through three big waterfalls, toward bravely Niagara Falls all the way, abundant river like energizes came to you, just in a hazy spray, you can feel the power and momentum of the waterfall. Out of the storm circle, it is like a boat returning from a previous adventure.(If Maid of Mist closed, substitute "IMAX movie legend", which also can let you experience the Niagara Falls' "thunder" and "lightning", as if, as it were, but definitely not get "wet").

When back to the shore after the end falls, we come to the foot of the waterfall by following the tour guide. Along Niagara wooden walkway, climb halfway up the hill to the American Falls, closely feeling the splash of spectacular waterfall. Finally, we come to state park, where are many amusements and small shops in the summer, and sometimes a local flea market, selling local Indian artifacts. After it, we will cross the [Rainbow Bridge]-symbol of the United States and Canada strengthened friendship, then get into Canada. Exterior view [Skylon Tower], where has theatre, entertainment center and restaurant. Tour guide can help to make reservation if guests would to enjoy the meals on their own expense. 360-degree rotating restaurant above 775 feet from Niagara Falls, guests can not only enjoy lunch there, but also appreciate the panoramic view the Falls in the sky.

Niagara-on-the-lake (60 mins)

We go inside Niagara-on-the-lake, which is the earliest was selected as the capital of Canada, and was named the most beautiful city in Canada in 1996. Exterior view [Cenotaph], [Prince of Wales Hotel], following by a chance to come to one of the famous Winery in Canada, where we can taste Canadian Ice wine, and also visit the wineries.

Human Exploration (120 mins)

Enter and take photos in front of the main building of the university of Toronto, exterior view [The Parliament Buildings], [Toronto City Hall], and the landmark of Toronto--[CN Tower].

Dinner at the third largest Chinatown in North America, guests can enjoy a special Toronto seafood dinner (meals on their own expense).

Day 3

Thousand Island-Ottawa-Quebec

(Activity time: 10-11 hours. Distance: 350 miles)

Hotel: Radisson/Holiday Inn or similar

(Summer: 4/1-10/31, Since Thousand Island Cruise open)

Thousand Island Cruise (60 mins)

Take the "Thousand Island Cruise" to visit the three natural wonders of [Thousand Island National Park]. The cruise will take a leisurely tour among the islands and guests will enjoy the mansions and islands of different style and sizes. Meanwhile, guests will also enjoy the delicious lunch (meals on their own expense).

Canadian Capital (90 mins)

Exterior view [Capitol hill], [La Fontaine Park], [National War Memorial], [Parliamentary Bells], [Centennial Flame] and clock in OTTAWA landmark, exterior view [Rideau Hall]. Guests may have chance to take picture with the soldiers.

Ancient City (90 minutes)

In the afternoon, we arrive at the [Fairmont Le Château Frontenac], start a wide boardwalk overlooking the city. [Old Quebec] is located in the southeast Quebec City, it is the only city in North America with a walled fortress. Road signs and signboards in English and French are everywhere, and pedestrians are dressed in European style. Romantic and warm outdoor café, strolling in the cobblestone pedestrian street, buying art at Square Louis, as like walking in Paris of France. Along the ancient city wall,

follow the tour guide to admire the various French architecture, step on the paved streets, and listen to the old story of the city. Quebec City is a historic city in North America, was listed as a world heritage site in 1985. Guests also have opportunities to taste French food (meals at your own expense), like French conch, foie gras and other famous dishes.

(Winter: 11/1-3/31, Since Thousand Island Cruise closed)

Kingston, Canada (60 mins)

Visit [Old Parliament Building], which is the city hall now, sightseeing the famous [Queen's University] and the [Royal Military College of Canada] on the bus.

Canadian Capital (90 mins)

Exterior view [Capitol hill], [La Fontaine Park], [National War Memorial], [Parliamentary Bells], [Centennial Flame] and clock in OTTAWA landmark, exterior view [Rideau Hall]. Guests may have chance to take picture with the soldiers.

Day 4

Montreal-Boston (Activity time: 11-12 hours. Distance: 350 miles)

Romance City (120 mins)

Exterior view the world's tallest leaning tower [Olympic Stadium], which is located in Montreal Olympic Park was home to many of the venues from the 1976 Summer Olympics. This outdoor stadium and its tilted tower have become a symbol of Montreal. Then we go to the highest hill in local area, [Mount Royal], where we overlook the center of Montreal. Next, we come to the old Montreal, the old harbor as the famous scenic spot in Montreal, admiring the antiques made of stone are all European-style elegant buildings. Finally, exterior view [Notre-Dame Basilica of Montreal], its size is a quarter of the building of [Notre-Dame de Paris].

Price Excluded:

1. All meals and drinks during the trip are not included in tour price. (Tour guide is only responsible for the arrangement. About breakfast: generally, tour guide will arrange you to have breakfast near the first scenic spot or inform you to prepare the next day's breakfast 1 day in advance.);
2. Mandatory service fees for tour guide and driver (minimum \$12.00 per day per passenger; children and infants are charged as adults)
3. Overtime activity (Niagara Falls has night tour, the fees are paid as overtime working fee for the driver and tour guide. Adults \$35 per person, children \$25 per person. Guests can choose 100% freely: go back to hotel to rest, or with tour guide to enjoy the local night view.)
4. Any private expenses, such as hotel room laundry, telephone bills, or fines for smoking, etc.

Notes to participants:

1. The 3rd or 4th free visitors are required to notify us more than 3 days earlier if they want to cancel the trip. No-show on the departure date will be charged a fine with \$130.
2. The admission fee is used to pay for guests 'hotels, transportation and attraction tickets. We need to prepaid the hotel before check-in, otherwise the hotel will not be able to provide rooms.
3. Itinerary will be subject to traffic and weather. The sequence of the attractions might be changed according to actual and practical situation for better service.
